

# Trip Tips for Trip Planners

## Type of Trip

- Work with Three Rivers Staff to decide which trip is best suited for your group. Focusing your groups' choices will help to eliminate confusion.

## Lodging

- Determine what type of lodging and the number of nights. A two-night stay is recommended. We start early in the morning and you will probably be tired at the end of the day.

- The Boatman's Bar & Grill – Full Service Bar/Restaurant
- Cabins with Electricity and Showers
- Shower Houses for Campers
- Pool Table, Horseshoes, Volleyball & Basketball

## Money Tips

- Set a deadline for payment and stick to it.
- Collect the entire amount, not just the 50% deposit.
- Collecting the deposit and then the balance is twice as much work.

## Extra Tips

- Fewer stops will reduce travel time.
- Gas Up in Skowhegan.
- Extra footwear is a plus.

## Kennebec or Dead River

- Take Interstate 95 to Exit 133 (*Formerly Exit 36*) (Skowhegan/Fairfield). Continue north on Rt. 201 (57.5 miles) through Skowhegan, Solon and Bingham. Approximately 20 miles after leaving the town of Bingham watch for the flashing Moose Sign. You are exactly 4.8 miles from "The Home of *Serious Fun*" and Kelley Brook Campground.

## Penobscot River

- Take interstate 95 north to exit 6A onto 295 north, which merges with 95 north again in Gardiner. Continue north and take exit 244 off I-95. Follow Route 11 & 157 west toward Millinocket. Continue through Medway and East Millinocket. The Medway Road, the road to "The Home of *Serious Fun*" is on the left, exactly 8 miles from I-95 (same road as the airport). After left continue 1.2 miles and the entrance is on the right. Have a safe trip!"
